

Alumni Liaison Report to
St. Augustine Alumni Association Board of Directors
May 9, 2017

1. Thursday the 18th of May members of the class of 2017 will load up on busses and head up to Magic Mountain for sober grad night. Unlike Mr. Tweed and fellow instigators/members of the class of 1971, seniors in the previous few classes have seen their grad nights remain incident free so the tradition continues – For Now...
2. Thursday the 25th and Friday the 26th of May will mark the school's annual underclassman as well as senior awards assemblies. The assemblies will begin at 9am and alumni board members are welcome to attend. Senior Writing and Class poetry contest winners will be awarded.
3. The Distinguished Students Banquet will also be held on Friday the 26th Tom Hamms Lighthouse. At this event each year the school honors select seniors and underclassman are recognized for their achievements in academics, athletics, or Augustinian service throughout the year.
4. Saints will celebrate graduation on campus for the first time in some eight decades this year. On Friday June 2nd, members of the class of 1967 will join graduates of the class of 2017 in St. Augustine Commons for baccalaureate and graduation ceremonies. Baccalaureate will begin at 9:30 and there will be a short intermission with graduation ceremonies to follow.
5. The hosted luncheon for the class of 1967 will be followed by a tour of the campus and replace the alumni association reception previously held at US Grant and Westgate hotels.
6. This year's parochial soccer tournament will be held on Saturday June 3rd. There will be three games, with semi's being held at 10 and 11am and the championship game to be held at 12:30pm.
7. Alumni Storage for the new building has been tentatively identified as Storage Area 12 – This closet will be located immediately behind the fireplace and adjacent to the north side of the Commons Lobby.
8. The bidding for the building of Phase III, which will feature a new performing arts center, music studio, and weight room, is currently being undertaken and the awarded construction company is set to begin work on the adaptive re-use of Daugherty gym the end of July.
